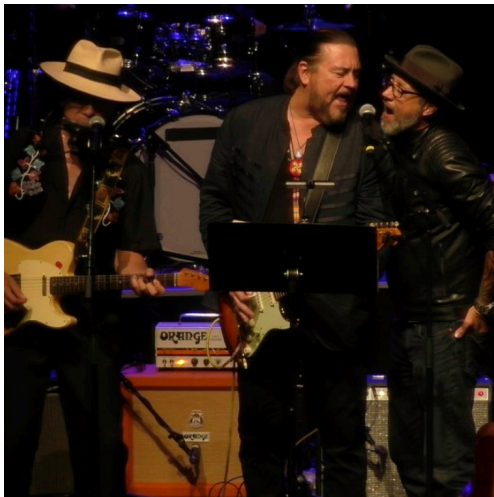
Tuesday November 6 1:00 PM
